



Guardian Student Stewardship Program Middle School

Stewardship hours are required by all middle school students as part of our religion curriculum and to further awareness that service to others is what Christ called of all of us. An emphasis on **community service** will be stressed as part of STGGCS stewardship.

Guidelines

- Each middle school student must volunteer for at least 8 hours each trimester. ***Two of the 8 stewardship hours from each trimester must be served at St. Gregroy the Great Catholic Church (e.g., altar serving, donut ministry).***
- Stewardship hours must be completed as part of students' religion grade.
- Household responsibilities, such as chores or babysitting a sibling do not count towards stewardship hours.
- Service performed during school hours will not count towards service hours unless pre-approved by religion teacher or principal.
- Stewardship Hours must be participated in without compensation, monetary or any other type.
- Stewardship Hours for the 2025-2026 school year can begin June 10, 2025.

Submitting Hours

STGGCS uses Mobile Serve app to track student and family stewardship. Students should submit the number of service hours using the Mobile Serve app (service hours will be approved by supervisor of event).



Students and families should have separate Mobile Serve accounts so the hours can be tracked accordingly.
