

Guardian Family Stewardship Program

Service and stewardship are central components of the philosophy of St. Gregory the Great Catholic School and Parish. Parent involvement in the school community sends a powerful message to our students that each of us is called to service by sharing the gifts of our time, talent, and treasure. The Guardian Family Stewardship Program encourages parents to be active participants in the education of their children, builds our community, and forms a strong bond between home, school, and church.

Stewardship Responsibilities:

Each family is responsible for completing the following.

- The service hours are to be earned beginning June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026.
- Two Parent Families: A minimum of 30 stewardship hours of which **8 hours will be dedicated to serving the Parish.**
- Single Parent Family: A minimum of 15 stewardship hours of which **3 hours will be dedicated to serving the Parish.**
- **Active participation in the spring gala is required of all STGGCS families.**
 - **Participation Options:**
 - Attendance (purchase of at least two tickets),
 - Sponsorship (business or table sponsorship)
 - Volunteering (a minimum of 4 volunteer hours directly related to the spring gala).

Donations:

We are grateful for all donations made to classrooms and school events! All donations (no matter the amount spent) will count for one service hour per event.

St. Gregory the Great Catholic School and parish provides a multitude of stewardship opportunities that accommodate all family schedules.

Submitting Hours:

STGGCS uses Mobile Serve app to track student and family stewardship. Families should submit the number of service hours using the Mobile Serve app (service hours will be approved by supervisor of event).



Families may opt to pay a non-participation fee of \$900 (\$30 for each unearned hour) or \$450 for single parent families. Active parent involvement is preferred.
